Open to ALL work on exhibition and as chosen by the public – to be announced on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023**.

\* The objective of the Environmental Art Prize is to raise awareness or highlight any environmental issue or problem that is occurring at a local, national or global level.

This year the subject is 'Endangered Flora & Fauna'.

## Conditions of entry

1. All entry forms must be submitted to the Pacific Palms Art Festival Committee no later than **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023**. Entry fees as applicable must accompany entry.
2. Entries must be a current original work of the exhibitor, not previously exhibited in the Great Lakes Area.
3. All Artists must be **17** years or over to enter.
4. All entries are to be for sale. **Identification tags (supplied) are to be placed on the back of the artwork**. Exhibitors should consider GST when pricing works.
5. Entries must be suitably framed with secure hooks and tight wire and be ready for hanging.
6. Size: Entries are not to exceed 100cm x 125cm including frame. Diptych & triptych paintings must be securely joined together as we cannot handle them individually.
7. Weight: Weight limit not to exceed 4 kg per work including frame (Please remember – glass is heavy)
8. **No wet works will be accepted.**
9. There is a maximum of 3 entries by any one exhibitor
10. Delivery of exhibits: Delivery can be made to the school hall at Pacific Palms Public School on **Monday 5<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 9am to 1pm**
11. Collection of works: Collection of works from the **school hall at Pacific Palms Public School on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June 10am to 12 noon.**

ARTWORKS NOT COLLECTED BY 12 NOON WILL INCUR A HANDLING FEE OF **\$20**

12. Organisers will display works at the **Pacific Palms Public School** from 7pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June to 4pm on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2023.
13. A Commission of 25% will be charged on all works sold by the Committee.
14. The decision of the judge or judges will be final and no correspondence entered into.

15. All freight and transport costs to be met by the artist.
  16. Every endeavour will be made to exhibit all entries. The Committee will represent each artist and reserves the right to determine entries to be exhibited.
  17. In the event that the number of entries exceeds the space available for hanging, the Committee will consider order of hanging preferences (on the completed entry form).
  18. This event maybe impacted by no-notice Covid-19 restrictions or natural disaster, in this instance one of the following contingencies will go ahead:
    - Reduced venue capacity
    - The event will be postponed
    - The event will be cancelled
  19. Last minute communications about changes to the event will only be via email and is the responsibility of the artists to remain across communications.
  20. Items will not be insured by the Committee. Insurance during transit and for the length of the exhibition will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
  21. The Committee reserves the right to allow reproduction of exhibitors work by the media.
  22. Proof of identity will be required from the exhibitor when claiming unsold items at the conclusion of the exhibition.
  23. There will be no provision made for late entries. (i.e. will not be included in catalogue).
  24. All artworks are to be available at the advertised price.
  25. Exhibitors should be aware that normal conditions regarding GST will apply.
  26. The winner of the acquisitive Pacific Palms Art Prize produces an original artwork to be raffled at the next Pacific Palms Art Festival.
- All due care will be taken by the Committee - no responsibility will be taken for works that are not collected.
